



"WORLD PEACE: IT BEGINS WITH YOU AND ME"

General Description of Entry

1. Louisiana students, either individually or as part of a group or class, is invited to take part in the Louisiana World Peace Day activities by submitting an entry describing his/her vision and ideas of World Peace through art (painting, drawing, etc.), photograph, essay, poem, music or video. If chosen, the entry will be displayed at the Louisiana State Capitol, Memorial Hall, during the month of October 2017.
2. The entry is not to contain any offensive or obscene references, connotations, gestures, or language.
3. The Louisiana World Peace Day Committee is partnering with the youth members of the Legislative Youth Advisory Council (LYAC) in this effort. All secondary schools, including public, nonpublic, and, home schools, are invited to participate.
4. Each student submitting an entry must submit a completed Entry Form and Parental Permission Form.
5. Student entries will be selected from the exhibition and the selected students will be invited to participate in the World Peace Day opening ceremony on Sunday, October 1, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. The work of the selected students may be used for promotional purposes for future World Peace Day events.
6. Entries may be submitted the following ways:

 - (b) All other artistic work (paintings, drawings, photographs, music, videos, etc.) may be either: mailed to World Peace Day Committee, P.O. Box 44343, Baton Rouge, LA 70804; OR, delivered to the LA State Capitol by calling (225) 342-0391 to coordinate the delivery.

Entries must be received by the committee on or before Friday, September 22, 2017, to be considered for display.
